He also stated it takes money to build a community center, in which the Township does have the finances to do so. Mayor Wright stated Sicklerville United Methodist Church has

plans for a community center. He welcomed Mr. Bethea to view the Township's budget and to meet with him and Mr. Gallagher.

Committeewoman Leverett arrived at 8:05 pm.

CLOSING PRAYER:

The Municipal Clerk provided the closing prayer.
