Aluminum & metal cans

#1, #2 and #4, #5, #7 Plastic food & beverage containers (caps removed)

Phone books

Cartons

Corrugated cardboard & Paper bags (flattened)

Greeting cards, regular & junk mail

Cardboard beverage carriers

Newspapers, magazines, brochures & inserts (no bags, do not tie & bundle)

Paperboard boxes (cereal, pasta & tissue)

NO NEED TO REMOVE:
Paper clips, stamps, address labels, staples, metal fasteners, cellophane address windows, rubber bands, spiral bindings, plastic tabs

NO

- Scrap metal
- Plastic bags
- Plastic lids & caps
- Plastic 6-pack holders
- Needles or syringes
- Plastic microwave trays
- Frozen food, ice cream or frozen juice containers
- Window panes, mirrors, ceramics & Pyrex dishware
- Plastics other than those listed
- Paint, pesticides, oil & cleansers
- Stickers or address label sheet waste
- Waxed paper or waxed cardboard
- Styrofoam or paper to-go containers
- Organic material and food waste
- Electronic waste (batteries, cell phones, computers, etc.)

Glass bottles & jars

File folders, office paper

Loose metal jar lids & steel bottle caps

Paper towel rolls

Paperback books

Please flatten all cardboard boxes. Empty and rinse all containers.



AIM FOR MAXIMIZED RECYCLING

Start using your new Recycling & Trash Carts on your regular trash day during the week of January 4th 2016.

Place carts curb side with arrows pointing toward the street
at least **THREE FEET APART** from each other and
4 feet from mailboxes, fire hydrants, low hanging trees or shrubs, parked
cars, or utility poles-*so trucks can easily access the cart.*

Place your garbage cart at the curb or street by 7 a.m. on your scheduled collection day.

*Make sure you are placing the cart on the street with the arrows on the lids pointing toward the street

Large or bulky items such as sofas, toilets, wood furniture can go out on your regular day.

The following items will be picked up curb side on Friday's or Thursday's if Friday is a holiday....

- Refrigerators/freezers
- Stoves, appliances
- Air conditioners
- Metal (white goods)

ELECTRONICS such as TV's, computers, etc. must be brought to Public Works at 125 South Route 73 during business hours.

HOLIDAYS

The landfill is closed and waste will not be collected on the following holidays.



**New Year's Day
Memorial Day
July 4th
Labor Day
Thanksgiving
Christmas**

If the holiday falls on a weekday, your garbage, recycle, and yard waste collection will be delayed by one day for that week only!

The regular schedule will resume the following week.

For example: If the holiday falls on Thursday, then Thursday collection will be provided on Friday, Friday service will be provided Saturday, etc..



- ⊗ NO Car batteries or acid batteries
- ⊗ No Liquids
- ⊗ No Propane cylinders
- ⊗ No Oil based paints and solvents
- ⊗ No Tires
- ⊗ No Oil filters/used oil
- ⊗ No Construction debris
- ⊗ No Hazardous materials

**If any of these items are found in your cart, the cart will be tagged with a warning notice and not serviced until corrected for your next scheduled collection day. We will not come back any sooner.*



PAPER & CARDBOARD

Newspaper, white paper, magazines, and cardboard should be placed in your recycling container

All recycle containers need to be empty and rinsed out with no food or debris in them.

- **DO NOT RECYCLE:** plastic trash bags

Your old trash cans can be used for yard waste or you can recycle your old can on your trash day.
