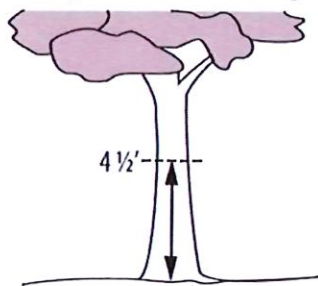

2. Draw a sketch or attach a site plan/survey of trees proposed to be removed

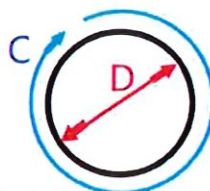
In your sketch, include the road your house is on, your house, and driveway in relation to the tree(s).

Trees are 6" or larger in diameter at breast height (DBH), measured at 4.5' above ground – when the trunk splits below DBH, it is 2 trees. See below. All trees proposed for removal MUST be marked with TAPE ONLY around trunk.

Take the circumference of the circle, divide it by π to get the diameter

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- 3. Tree removal information-** application must be submitted at least 14 business days prior to proposed removal
- A copy of the applicant's property survey, site plan or hand drawn map with the trees to be removed clearly located is required for this application to be considered.
 - The submittal of a tree mitigation replacement plan may be required and is indicated below.
 - Approved permits are valid for 90 Days

APPLICANT SIGNATURE

By signing the application below, you are acknowledging the requirements for tree replacements AND the penalties for violations of the tree removal permit requirements:

Violations and penalties; costs charged against lands; enforcement. Violations and penalties. Any person violating any of the provisions of this article shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$500 nor more than \$5,000 per tree and/or imprisonment in the county jail for a period not to exceed 90 days and/or 90 days of community service. Each tree damaged, removed or destroyed in violation of this article shall be considered a separate offense, and a separate fine shall be levied for each tree. In addition, the court shall require the guilty party to replace trees that have been removed or damaged in violation of this article, in accordance with the tree replacement schedule in Section 270 of this chapter.

The applicant, by applying for this permit, is authorizing Winslow Township personnel to access the property for tree inspections.
